

SHARING THE LEGACY MAP OF VALLETTA

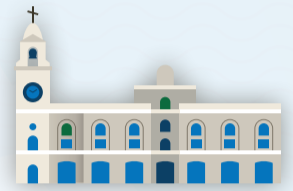


FORT ST. ELMO
Fort St. Elmo is a star-shaped fort built by the Order of St. John at the tip of the peninsula, on which Valletta is also built, to save guard the two main harbours of Malta – the Grand Harbour and Marsamxett Harbour. Fort St Elmo will be the main venue for the conference.
